Today's Music

Mark Hayes (Arranger) earned a Bachelor of Music in piano performance magna cum laude from Baylor University. Hayes' choral and orchestral writing is widely acclaimed and performed internationally. He is well known for his unique choral and vocal settings, which draw from diverse styles such as gospel, jazz, pop, folk and classical to achieve a truly "American" sound. Mark has consistently received the ASCAP Standard Award and has won the prestigious Dove Award from the Gospel Music Association, which is equivalent to a Grammy in gospel music.

"On Eagles' Wings" is a sacred song composed by Michael Joncas, a Catholic priest in 1979. It's words are loosely based on Psalm 91 and Isaiah 40:31. It quickly proved to be quite popular as a contemplative song and is now sung in many denominations. It was performed at many of the memorial services of the victims of September 11th. Fr. Joncas indicated in "On Eagles' Wings" that the wings belong to many eagles, since there would be many eagles needed to lift up the multiple people in covenant with God.
