Today's Music

"Holy, Holy, Holy" is one of our most beloved hymns of praise, and one of the richest in doctrine. The words were written by Reginald Heber (1783-1826), an Anglican minister who eventually became the Bishop of Calcutta, India. Born in England to very wealthy parents, the Oxford-trained minister worked his entire career in less-than-favorable surroundings, and died of apparent heat stroke after delivering a sermon to an outdoor crowd.

John Dykes composed the music for these words in 1861 for use on Trinity Sunday (eight weeks after Easter), and the hymn (words and music) collectively speaks to our belief in the Triune God. Therefore the hymn tune was named NICAEA, after the famous council which took place in A.D. 325. The decision of this council affirmed the doctrine of the Trinity.
