*"Zion's Walls" is an old American revivalist song that was first published in The Social Harp in 1855. Aaron Copland (1900-1990), whom many consider to be the "Father of American Music" for helping break from European tradition, wrote an arrangement of Zion's Walls for solo voice and piano. This choral version of the same arrangement preserves the rugged leaps in the melody but adds tricky cross-rhythms to heighten the idea of having joy in the worship of God.*
