"The words of today's anthem were written by Percy Dearmer (1867-1936), a noted English priest and poet who, with Ralph Vaughan Williams edited the 1906 English Hymnal which became a standard for all hymnals in the 20th Century. "Draw Us In The Spirit's Tether" takes as its origin Mt: 18:20-"Where two or three are gathered in my name, there will I be in their midst." As the disciples met Christ for a meal in the upper room, so should we use our regular daily activities as opportunities to show Christ's love to each other and the world. The music is by Harold Friedell (1901-1958), an American church musician who taught at Union Theological Seminary in New York.
