### Today's Music

*Today's special music comes largely from the African-American protestant worship tradition. Josephine Poelinitz' arrangement of "City Called Heaven" is a "sorrow song" that is sung in a style some call "surge singing." This comes from the old tradition (in both Anglo and Black churches) of a soloist or leader "lining out" the song- due to the fact that most in the congregation could not read. In the Black tradition the leader was expected to embellish and the congregation/choir reacted to his/her singing-intertwining the singing back and forth.*

*"He's Got the Whole World in His Hands" is a well-known Spiritual that has many variants. This slower version is by the great American arranger Moses Hogan (1957-2003). Both pieces have a similar message: That things may look bleak-in our world and in our individual lives. However, God is still on the throne and will someday wipe away our tears, and lead us into a home called Heaven.*
