Today's Music

In the next few weeks as we travel into Lent, the choir will sing a variety of music from the last 500 years of Christendom- from an early Protestant anthem to modern Gospel music. Today's anthem is a festive hymn arrangement by Mack Wilberg, and requires a choir large enough to split into eight separate parts. "Come, Thou Fount of Every Blessing" is one of my personal favorites. The words are by Robert Robinson (1735-1790). Born into poverty in England, his father died when Robert was eight. He later became a juvenile delinquent, but was saved after hearing a sermon by George Whitfield. Robinson eventually became a minister and theologian. The words of the second verse, "Here I raise mine Ebebezer," refers to the stone of help in I Samuel 7:12. The tune comes from America and is named NETTLETON after Asahel Nettleton, an American evangelist of the early 18th Century. Words and music came together in John Wyeth's *Repository of Sacred songs* of 1813.
