## Today's Music

*"Hail to the Lord's Anointed" was written by Scotsman James Montgomery (1771-1854). He was the son of Moravian missionaries who died in the West Indies when he was 19. He was once expelled from school for spending too much time writing poetry, but it is as a writer of Christian verse that we know him today. He was influential in 19th Century hymn writing in both Methodist and Anglican churches, and this hymn is set to a German folk tune. He also wrote the words to "Angels from the Realms of Glory" and "Go to Dark Gethsemane," which will be sung in worship during Holy Week.*
