Today's Music

Today's Prelude, Postlude and Anthem are all compositions of Felix Mendelssohn (1809-1847). Mendelssohn was born to wealthy Jewish parents who converted to Christianity. Young Felix was a child prodigy who began composing at an early age. Though he endured anti-Semitism even though he was a Christian, Mendelssohn wrote some of the most influential classical music with Christian themes in the 19th Century, including the oratorios *Elijah* and *St. Paul*, and the "Reformation" Symphony. He is also credited with reviving the music of J.S. Bach, the most famous "reformed" church musician of all time.
