Today you will notice two grand pianos on the chancel. One is ours and one has been rented for the Three Texan Tenors concert this afternoon at 4:00PM. Since the extra piano was to be here anyway I asked several of our wonderful resident keyboardists to prepare arrangements for either four or eight hands, and they have responded magnificently. Piano duos/quartets are a tradition that dates back to the 19th Century, before the age of recorded music and television. Since the average person was unable to attend a live orchestral concert, it became popular to make orchestral transcriptions for multiple keyboards. This not only allowed persons in small towns to hear the newest music, it also provided repertoire for pianists to play together. Though this tradition has waned in the 21st Century, there is still a large body of music written for this combination, and we are blessed to worship God through the collective talents of our keyboardists this morning.
