Today's Music

Today there is much music associated with the name Wesley. The words to "O for a Thousand Tongues to Sing" and "And Can It Be?" are by Charles Wesley (1707-1788), one of the leaders in the "Great Awakening" of the 18th Century. Charles and his brother John also helped form what eventually became the Methodist Church. Charles wrote over 6,500 hymns in his lifetime—an amazing number for any era. Today's anthem, "Thou Wilt Keep Him in Perfect Peace," is by Samuel Sebastian Wesley (1819-1876), Charles' grandson. Sebastian was an accomplished organist, composer and reformer of church music in England in the 19th Century. This piece uses fragments of several scriptures to highlight the Christian's need to keep our mind focused on the Lord.
