### Today's Music

*"Notes from Paul" was written by Eugene Butler, a composer, professor, and church musician in the Kansas City area. It was commissioned by a church in Dallas, and combines repeating phrases from several passages from the Pauline Epistles into a single statement.*

*"The Lost Chord" was written by Sir Arthur Sullivan around the time of his brother's death in 1877. It became very popular throughout England, and was one of Sullivan's most famous songs. The poetry is by Adelaide Proctor (1825-1864). Sullivan tried to set these words a few years earlier, but could not. However, during the terrible days of watching his brother suffer he found comfort in the poem, and this inspired him to compose.*
