Summer Youth Intern Position Summary

The First Pres Kingwood summer youth internship program is an opportunity to learn about student ministry and serving in the local church with immersive, Christ-centric experiences and responsibilities. The summer intern's primary role will be to engage with middle school and high school students, helping them to grow in and take ownership of their relationship with God while assisting full-time staff in their weekly programming activities. On the First Pres Kingwood student ministry staff, the summer intern is treated as an integral part of our mission to serve God's Kingdom by walking alongside students in faith. The internship is a twelve-week long program designed with the hope that the intern will gain valuable experience in ministry to create disciples of younger generations after it ends.

Responsibilities

- The summer intern's primary objective will be to spend time with students in various roles and environments, ministering to and connecting them with Christ.
- The summer intern's secondary objective will be to work alongside the youth ministry staff, coordinating, planning, and preparing for various summer events and activities.

Requirements

Faith

The summer intern should be an individual who is wholeheartedly pursuing Christ in his or her life, striving to carry out the Great Commandment of loving God and loving others. They should be a person of integrity, someone who bears godly fruit in their lives and is committed to

growing spiritually in their personal walk with Jesus. We don't ask for perfection, only a willingness and passion for living out their faith as a spiritual mentor to students.

Age

The applicant must be two years removed from high school graduation.

Education

Applicants should have at least a high school diploma or GED certificate.

Transportation

It is essential interns have access to a vehicle.

Background Check

In compliance with church policy, the applicant must pass a background check and, if hired, is required to complete an online Sexual Abuse Awareness course.

Position Description

Hours

- The internship is a full-time position beginning at the end of May and finishing in August. We will set the exact dates based on the intern's school schedule.
- During the summer months, the youth staff is working 40+ hours a week focusing on spending time with students. This requires a flexible work schedule that adjusts to best fit opportunities to spend time with students. The summer intern should plan on spending at

least five days a week in the office. Applicants should also prepare to go on at least one, maybe two, weeklong mission trips.

Total Hours Per Week: ~40

Pay

\$3,000 for the summer.
